Tissue Donation

Although less widely publicized than organ donation, tissue donation saves or enhances the lives of over a million people in the U.S. each year. Tissue can be donated upon one's death to others in medical need.

HEART VALVES

Replace damaged or defective heart valves. Improve heart function.

EYE

Replace diseased or damaged cornea, reinforce wall of the eye. Restore vision and prevent blindness.

SKIN

Grafts for burn victims, abdominal wall repair, breast reconstruction after mastectomy and rotator cuff repair. Promote healing, reduce scarring and restore abdominal wall.

BONE

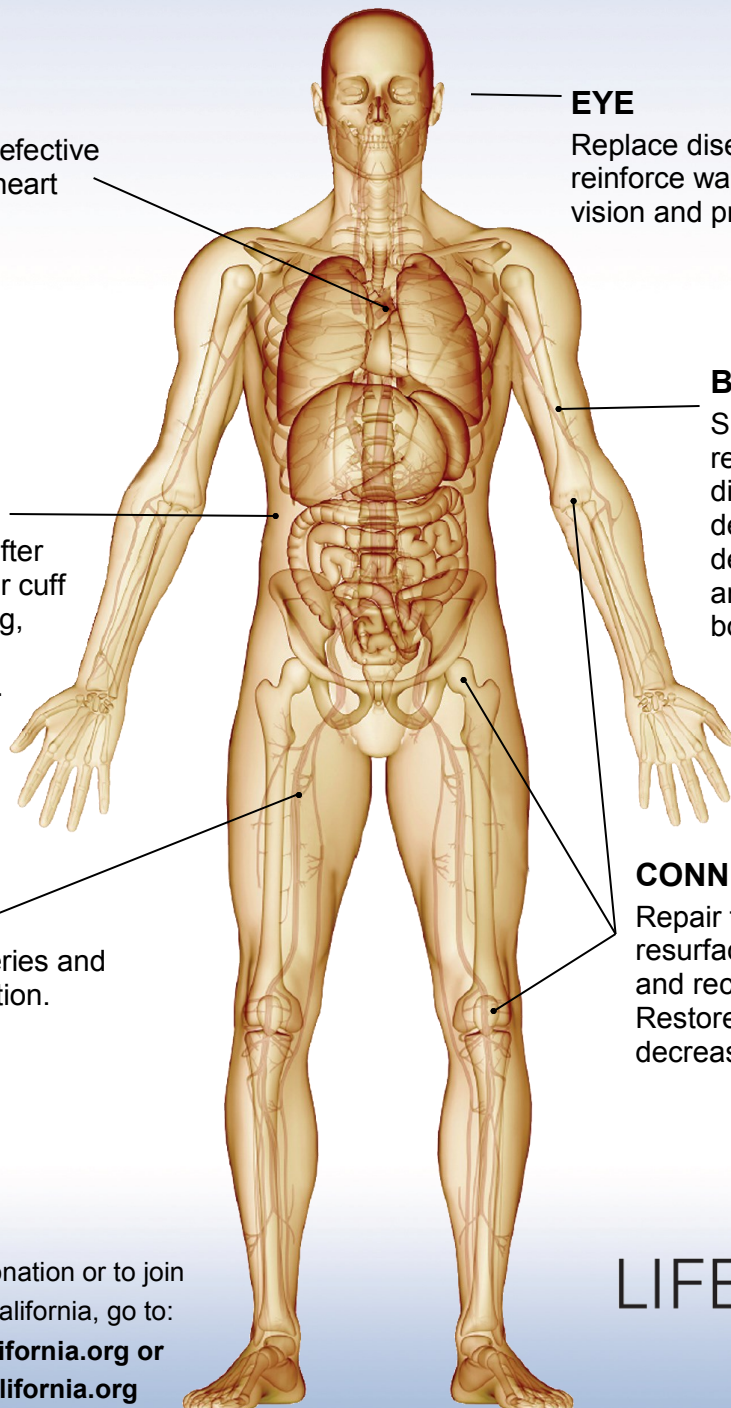
Spinal fusion, reconstruction related to trauma, tumors, disease and fractures and fill defects. Restore mobility, decrease pain, prevent amputation and collapse of bone.

BLOOD VESSELS

Replace damaged arteries and veins. Increase circulation.

CONNECTIVE TISSUE

Repair fascia deformity and resurface joints. Replacement and reconstruction of tendons. Restore appearance, mobility and decrease pain.
